**Subject: The Meeting of the SATRC Working Group on Spectrum,  
21 – 23 June 2022, New Delhi, India (Republic of)**

The 45th Session of the Management Committee of the APT (MC-45) approved the South Asian Telecommunication Regulators' Council (SATRC) as one of the Work Programmes for 2022. I would like to inform you that the APT will organize the Meeting of the SATRC Working Group on Spectrum from 21 to 23 June 2022 in New Delhi, India. The Meeting will be hosted by Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI).

The Meeting of SATRC Working Group on Spectrum is a part of the activities of SATRC Action Plan Phase VIII (SAP-VIII) which was adopted by the 22nd Meeting of SATRC (SATRC-22) held virtually in 2021. It will be the first meeting of the Working Group under SATRC Action Plan Phase VIII and it is expected to discuss the Work Items assigned to the Working Group by the Council.

In this connection, I would like to invite your organization to consider sending your experts who have been nominated for this Working Group by your organization to attend the meeting. The list of experts is attached herewith for your kind information. The presence of the enlisted experts is essential for the successful implementation of SAP-VIII. Additional experts and representatives from the SATRC Member countries as well as from Affiliate Members of APT in those countries are also welcome. The host may arrange a virtual/online meeting platform for the participants in case there are participants who cannot join the meeting in person.

In order to facilitate participation and as decided by the SATRC-22, the APT will provide two (2) fellowships (maximum) for the enlisted experts from your organization. The fellowship will cover economy class return air ticket, hotel accommodation and pocket allowance. Please note that fellowship will not cover any costs entailed by the COVID-19 pandemic situation and conditions set by any authorities. Such additional cost for physical attendance should be borne by the fellowship participants or their administration. Please, also note that APT may not provide fellowship to all applicants.
