7. WIRELESS LAN

Internet Access over wireless network will be available during the meeting. APT encourages the use of electronic documents during the meeting. The participants are kindly requested to bring their own laptops with Wi-Fi capability.

8. TRANSPORTATION FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE VENUE:

The main airport serving international flights in Jakarta is Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, located in South Tangerang, Banten (approximately 30 km away from the venue, which takes around 1 hour by car/taxi depending on traffic).

The host would not provide shuttle bus or transportation for delegates to the meeting venue. The participants are encouraged to kindly make their own transport arrangements to/from the venue.

Taxi

There are several taxi companies available at the Soekarno-Hatta International Airport as you exit the terminal. You can expect to pay approximately IDR 300,000 each way. The most respected and reliable taxi service in Jakarta is provided by the **Blue Bird Group**.

Private Ride-sharing Transportations

Currently there are two main ride-sharing services commonly used in Jakarta: **Grab** and **Gojek**. Both **Gojek** and **Grab** are usually about 10-20% cheaper than taking a taxi following the meter. This can vary though during surges and peak traffic times. You can download both Go-Jek and Grab on Google Play/App Store.

It is possible to get picked up by Gojek and Grab drivers at Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, but you need to reach the official “pick up” point at the airport

Airport Railink

It is a practical option to get from Soekarno-Hatta International Airport all the way to central Jakarta (or vice versa).

1. Once you arrive at Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, you need catch the airport train at respective terminal, which will take you to **Soekarno-Hatta Integrated Train Station (SHIA)**. This is where all airport trains from each terminal go before the main trains head to the city centre.
2. Once you arrive at SHIA, you need to purchase a ticket to **BNI (City) Station**. Under most circumstances, it takes around 45 minutes to reach **BNI City Station** in Central Jakarta.
3. Once you arrive at **BNI City Station**, the easiest/quickest way to get to the venue, Hotel Mulia Senayan Jakarta, is by taxi or ride-share services (Gojek / Grab)

9. INSURANCE AND MEDICAL EMERGENCIE

The APT and Local Secretariat will not bear any cost of insurance and medical for the participants. The APT and Local Secretariat, therefore, request your Administrations/ Organizations to kindly make necessary arrangements for insurance and medical coverage of your delegates before traveling to the Republic of Indonesia.

10. PRACTICAL INFORMATION:

Jakarta Quick Facts:

- The capital of Indonesia, with a population of about 10.7 million
- **Spoken languages:** Indonesian (Bahasa Indonesia). Malay and English are occasionally spoken
- **Weather:** Jakarta’s climate is classified as tropical. Currently it is a dry season (sunny) with average temperature around 28 - 32°C
- **Time zone:** UTC/GMT +7

- **International dialing code:** +62
- **Currency:** Indonesian Rupiah (IDR), The exchange rate as of June 2024 is IDR 16,513 to 1 USD.
- **Banks:** Banks are commonly open from Monday to Friday 08:00 – 15:00. ATMs are available in various spots for 24 hours. Visa and Mastercard are most widely accepted in Indonesia, but credit and debit cards are mainly only used in bigger/official stores/tenants.
- **Electricity:** Power sockets in Indonesia are two pin types C and E/F and the standard voltage is 230V with 50 Hz frequency
