

Special sessions for the election campaign by the candidates for the posts of the elected officials of the ITU

Objectives

- Provide an opportunity to APT Members to listen to each candidate's visions.
- Provide an opportunity to APT Members to know the candidates' personalities directly.
- Provide an opportunity for the candidates to express their visions and demonstrate their ability and personality.

Format and procedure

- 1) PP22-4 will be organized physically from 1-5 August 2022 in Bangkok, Thailand.
- 2) The special session(s) will be organized physically during the PP22-4, the first day of the meeting (1 August 2022).
- 3) The special session(s) will be during lunchtime and after the ordinary sessions in the afternoon.
- 4) The time slot for each candidate is strictly for 10 min.
- 5) A candidate can use presentation slides and/or video if they want. There will be no Q&A.
- 6) There will be two sessions, one for the candidates for SG and DSG during lunch time, and the other for the Directors of BR, TSB, and BDT after the ordinary sessions.
- 7) This is not a compulsory activity, and it is up to each candidate whether they join in this session.
- 8) If they accept the invitation, they must inform APT of their intention to join the session by 30 June 2022. APT will not accept to allocate a time slot after this deadline.
- 9) The order of time slot among the candidates for the same post will be determined by the arrival date of the letter or the email they reply to APT. (If the arrival date is the same, alphabetical order of their country name will be applied among them).
- 10) If they want to use slides or video, they have to submit it to APT Secretariat by 22 July 2022.
- 11) Language is English only. If they want to speak in other languages, they have to prepare translation functions by themselves. APT doesn't provide such a facility or operation.
- 12) The facilitator of these sessions will be coordinated between the Chair of the PP prep meeting and Secretary General of APT.
