Subject: APT Training Course on Preparing for International Conferences 7 - 10 March 2023, Bangkok, Thailand

I am pleased to inform you that the Asia-Pacific Telecommunity (APT) will organize a Training Course on Preparing for International Conferences 2023 (TCPIC-2023, "Mock Conference") from 7 to 10 March 2023 in Bangkok, Thailand. This training course provides opportunity to experience discussion, negotiation and coordination on a matter at an international meeting. This year, the training program will pick up World Telecommunication/ICT Policy Forum (WTPF) as a case study. This training course is funded by the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications (MIC), Japan (Extrabudgetary Contribution from Japan: EBC-J).

APT "Mock Conference" training course was launched in 2016 with the objective of providing necessary and effective training opportunities for people who are new to participating in international meetings and conferences.

International conferences are platforms for discussion, negotiation and decisionmaking on issues that involve participation at the multilateral level. Effective participation in international conferences requires, among others, a good understanding and knowledge of ways and processes of discussion, negotiation and decision-making. Therefore, this training course is designed to provide such opportunities and assist APT members in preparing better for participating in international conferences. Selection Criteria:

- Qualifications of an applicant:
- 1) Priority will be given to those who have not participated in this training course in the past.
- 2) He/she is in charge of attending international/regional meetings.
- 3) Junior officials and women are encouraged to apply.

Required Documents:

- A. Completed Nomination Form (Annex2) with current photo, and signatures of the Applicants, direct supervisor and APT official contact point. (APT shall not accept any nomination forms without the signature of APT official contact person.); and
- B. Copy of the applicant's passport with the details and photo page

Insurance:

APT will not be able to bear any cost of medical or travel insurance for the participant including any measures for Covid-19 such as quarantine, PCR test, etc. APT requests Administrations/Organizations to kindly make necessary arrangements for medical, travel insurance and others covering the whole period of the event and overseas travel for the participant.
