Guideline for ICT Volunteer Programme 2024

1. Introduction

The ICT Volunteer Programme, a collaborative initiative between the Asia-Pacific Telecommunity (APT) and the National Information Society Agency (NIA) of the Republic of Korea, aims to empower APT Members and partner organizations* through ICT training and ICT-related projects.

* Partner organizations: Institutions in Member countries interested in the programme, such as government and related agencies, NGOs, university, etc.

ICT Training and ICT project are promoted with the following contents, and are promoted in two forms, online and on-site, considering the current cross-border movement situation.

< ICT Training >

The ICT Volunteers will provide students and/or local residents in APT Member countries with ICT education and skills training in the following areas:

- Artificial Intelligence (Basic level of AI such as developing practice model using AI training data)
- Programming (Arduino, Python, C#, etc.)
- Graphic Design (Photoshop, video editing, etc.)
- Office Program (Word, PowerPoint, Excel, etc.)

< ICT Project >

Working with project managers of partner organization and providing consultations in certain ICT fields. ICT projects can range from website building, mobile application development, facility enhancement.

- website building such as developing an archive for e-documents by utilizing PHP on the purpose of inner usage of organization.
- project implementation using an Arduino kit which is for smart farm, transporting system, market management etc.

- i. The ON-SITE activity is based on the ONLINE activity.
- ii. The ON-SITE activity is optional, and it can only take place if both the volunteers and the organizations agree.
- iii. The ON-SITE activity is determined by NIA. The selection of participants for the ON-SITE activities is based on well-crafted and detailed application forms as well as effective communication engagement from the ONLINE teams.
- iv. The ON-SITE team will conduct half of the volunteer service period in an ONLINE and the remaining half in an ON-SITE.

Once the surveys are collected, we will look over which organizations are most appropriate to receive ICT Volunteers. This process is expected to be completed in May. If your organization is selected, the NIA will contact you before dispatching volunteers.
